

A countywide survey to help identify the needs of people with disabilities and other types of access and functional needs that may impact them during an emergency or disaster.




STEPS TO PREPARE

READINESS TO RESPOND




47%

During an emergency or disaster, respondents use a variety of sources, including social media, television, and the VC Emergency website to get information.




