Do I Qualify for VC NextGen?

In order to qualify for VC NextGen, you need to be between the ages 14-24 and have a barrier to employment or education. You can qualify regardless of your schooling/education status.

- Up to 150 hours of paid work experience
- Help with applying to college or vocational school
- Supportive services to help overcome barriers
- Connection to community resources
