

Human Services Agency Programs

Adoption Services

Assists birth parents and those seeking to adopt, including stepparents, relative caregivers and resource families.

Adult Protective Services

Responds to allegations of abuse and neglect of dependent adults and seniors; provides voluntary case management services.

CalFresh

Helps people with little or no income buy nutritious groceries with an electronic benefit transfer (EBT) card.

CalWORKs

Assists low-income or unemployed parents with dependent children by providing temporary financial assistance, subsidized child care and employment services.

Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI)

Provides cash assistance for eligible legal immigrants who are blind, elderly, or have a disability and who are ineligible for Supplemental Social Security Income/State Supplemental Payment (SSI/SSP) benefits.

Children & Family Services

Provides support to prevent family separations, safely reunite families as fast as possible, and ensure children and youth in the child welfare system keep lifelong family connections.

Employment Services

Provides services for both job seekers and employers that include training, recruitment and job search assistance at centers throughout the county.

Resource Families/Homes With Heart

Recruits and provides training and support for relatives, community members and families to temporarily care for children and youth in need of a safe and stable environment.

General Relief

Provides a short-term loan for eligible adults with no dependent children to assist with basic living needs, such as housing or utility payments.

Farmworker Resource Program

Assists farmworkers in Spanish, English, Mixteco, Purepecha and Zapoteco to connect with local services and community resources.

Health Care Enrollment

Provides access to no-cost and lower-cost health care programs, including Medi-Cal, and Affordable Care Act options for qualifying families with dependent children, seniors, adults and people with disabilities.

Homeless Services

Provides outreach and mobile intensive case management to homeless individuals and families and includes the RAIN Bridge Housing program.

In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS)

Assists older adults and people with disabilities to remain safely in their homes by connecting them with providers who help with personal care, housekeeping, shopping and errands.

IHSS Public Authority

Maintains a registry of providers for IHSS consumers, conducts recruitment and screening of providers, facilitates training and employment guidance for IHSS providers and consumers, and enrolls new providers.

Public Administrator

Investigates and administers the estates of people who die without a will or an appropriate person able to act as the administrator.

Ventura County Area Agency on Aging

Provides a wide range of resources and services to help older individuals, children and adults with disabilities, and their caregivers thrive.

Veteran Services

Assists veterans and their dependents with accessing benefits and services; provides advocacy for those who served in the armed forces.

Youth Services

Supports young adults in care through extended services that secure lifelong connections and prepare for independent living.
